

Our Story

Providence School of Tifton was founded by four families with a strong conviction that Tifton was in need of a quality Christian school. At its core, our vision was for a school that was academically rigorous, mission-minded, accessible, and unapologetically Christian. After much prayer and research, we fell upon classical Christian education and haven't looked back. Due to classical Christian education (CCE) training students *how* to think in addition to *what* to think, we knew that this type of education would powerfully prepare our students for a life lived in glory to God alone.

On August 7, 2020, we opened our doors to 35 students, 22 families, and 4 faculty members. In four years we have grown to 71 students, 48 families, and 13 faculty members from JK2 to Class Ten. The families in our school community represent more than fifteen local churches and five ethnicities. Additionally, we are one of only three accredited classical Christian schools in the Southcentral Georgia region.

Our curriculum is planned with the end in mind, focusing on planting, nourishing, and cultivating the souls of our students to watch them bear fruit as forty-, fifty-, and sixty-year-old men and women of God. We administered our first standardized test in 2023, which showed our students averaging up to four grades higher than the national averages for public and private schools.

The total projected cost for "Building a Legacy" for our future is \$1,000,000. We have reached the goal of occupancy in the first level, and the second level and the outdoor space are left to complete. Second-level renovations include a large space for gatherings and other school-wide events and classrooms. The rooftop will transform into useable space for outdoor gatherings, recess, lunch, and nature studies. It also includes owning the building - free and clear - within seven years. This positions us for the growth that is to come and the ability to purchase viable properties around us as the need and availability arises.

When all slots on the Table of Giving have been fulfilled, we will have raised \$1,167,200. This provides a projected surplus of \$167,240 to be used to further the mission and vision of Providence through scholarships, specialized educational programming, and the build-out of the School of Rhetoric.

In Phase Four, we are building for longevity, and in this phase we will raise the remaining 80% of the total cost of *owning* the building - \$600,000 - and have a sustainable, reliable building for the long-term use and growth of our students, families, and faculty of Providence School of Tifton.

Phase Two

Phase Three
